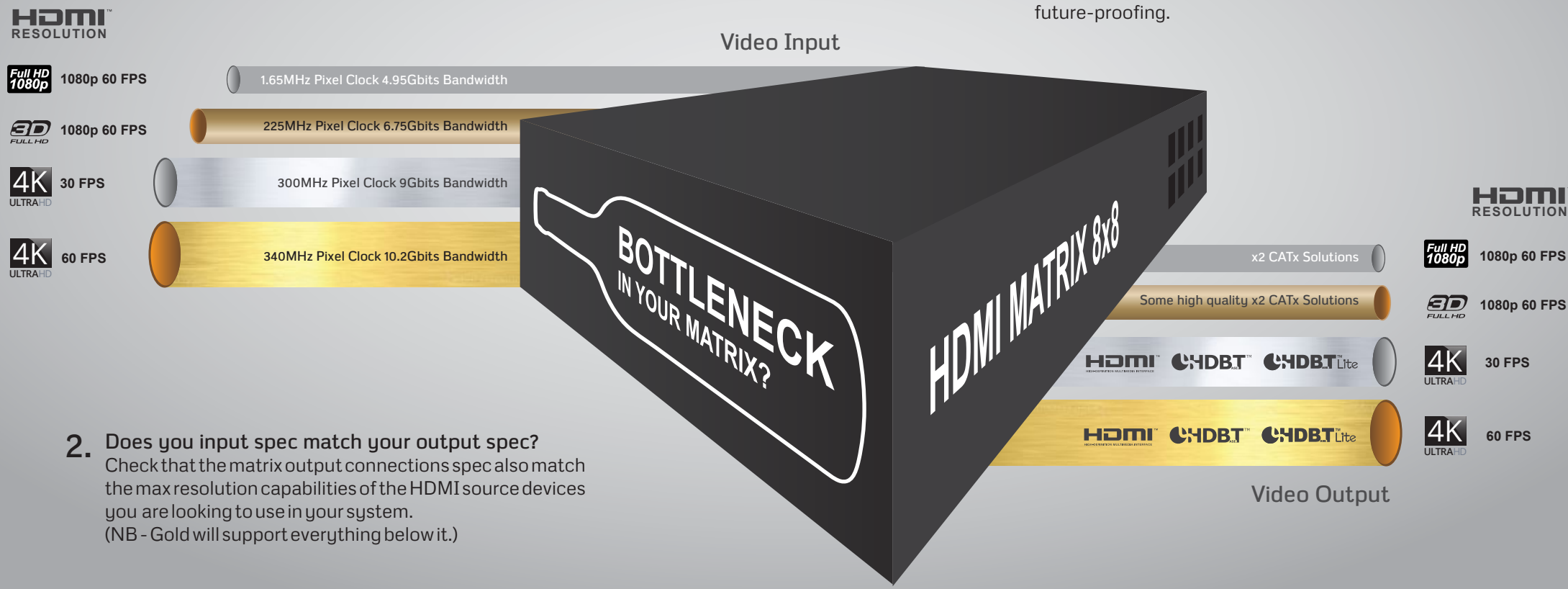




You're probably not comparing HD matrices on a like-for-like basis. Here's what to look out for.

- 1. What resolutions do you want your system to support now and potentially in the future?
Match the spec of your matrix input connections to the max resolution capabilities of the HDMI source devices you are looking to use in your system.

- 3. The Gold standard.
Make sure you have the Gold standard on both input and output side of your HD matrix to ensure maximum resolution capabilities and future-proofing.



- 2. Does your input spec match your output spec?
Check that the matrix output connections spec also match the max resolution capabilities of the HDMI source devices you are looking to use in your system.
